
## Award payments and total amount paid by SAAS, 2003-04 to 2012-13; estimated equivalent spend 2013-14 (£1000s)

It is not clear what changes to YSB or the wider environment are expected to have this effect. If this has not happened in practice, the estimate here will over-state spending, unless the profile of claimants has shifted significantly towards lower income groups between the 2 years. Each 5% overestimate of YSB spending would equate to £3m, or 3.5% of the total spend on grants. The figures are also based on a higher threshold for ISB than implemented in practice and may therefore slightly overstate potential ISB claimants and spend (b) Other continuing grants assumed to remain unchanged in real terms from previous year.
